INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC EQUIPMENT RENTAL

Equipment and Music

The school provides many large instruments, equipment, music, folders, and stands for the instrumental program. In turn, the students are responsible for the care of all classroom equipment and any equipment specifically assigned to them. Costs incurred due to neglect, damage, or loss is the student's obligation.

Rental

Any student using a school-owned instrument is responsible for its care and maintenance. Please see the GFPS rental agreement for all pertinent details.

Percussionists pay a fee to cover the use of many instruments throughout the school year.

Instrument Storage-Security

Storage space for large instruments is provided in the music area. Smaller instruments may be stored in students' lockers. Instruments should not be left overnight on a regular basis at EMS. All instruments should go home on weekends and long breaks.

Name Tags

Name tags on all instrument cases are <u>MANDATORY</u>. EMS tags are available for purchase (\$2) should a student choose to own one.

Risk Coverage

Insurance for privately-owned instruments is available at a low cost premium by the school district. Forms will be distributed in the fall.

GRADING

Grades are based on the following areas:

*Attendance *Class work and preparation Your child needs their instrument and music every day for maximum participation. *Quizzes and tests *Individual playing skills *Progress and improvement *Practice records *Performances (Please place your child's concert dates for the year on your calendar at home)

PRACTICE RECORDS

Practice is <u>mandatory</u> and <u>necessary</u> for the success of every music student.

Weekly practice records will require parent verification.

Neglect or failure to meet this class expectation will have a <u>substantial effect</u> on the grade for that grading period. Students experiencing difficulty in this area may be asked to make special arrangements for help.


